Pick one important event from the book to create a journal entry that captures that character's personality.</p> <p>Requirements for diary entry:</p> <p>___ at least fifteen sentences</p> <p>___ must capture the emotions of the character</p> <p>___ must be about a major event in the book</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Fortune Teller</u></b></p> <p>Make a prediction of a character's life in the future. Think about: Where will he/she live? What kind of job or career will he/she have? Will he/she still be friends with the same friends as before? Will he/she get married? Etc...</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <p>___ At least 1 prediction</p> <p>___ Explain why you think these predictions are accurate based on the character's personality and character traits</p> <p>___ include page numbers and quotes from the novel to help justify your predictions</p>
